

Greener Homes Loan & Grant

Application Process

The Canada Greener Homes Loan & Grant is a Federal rebate program incentive for Canadians to invest in energy efficient home retrofits. The Loan & Grant provides up to \$5,000 in the form of a grant and up to \$40,000 in the form of a loan with 0% interest and a 10 year repayment for eligible retrofits approved by a recognized Ener-Guide home auditor, plus up to \$600 to cover the cost of the evaluation. The Greener Homes Loan & Grant Application Process is as follows:

Step 1: Register for the Canada Greener Homes Loan & Grant online

Apply online with Natural Resource Canada (N.R.Can.), Loan& you should receive your application number within 48 hours. Once your application is processed, you will receive an approval from N.R.Can. via email.

Step 2: Book your Energy Evaluation

N.R.Can. provides a list of approved energy auditors – contact any of the listed energy auditors and contact them to book your energy assessment. Make sure that the energy auditor includes the recommendation for solar on your report.

Step 3: Install your solar energy system.

Once you have the energy evaluation report and the N.R.Can approval email, you can continue with your energy efficiency improvements or solar installations. All installations will only be preformed by a red seal electrician.

Step 4: Claim your reimbursement.

Once the project is complete, you can book the second Energy Guide home evaluation with your selected energy auditor. Then, you can apply to claim your rebate of up to \$5,000, plus up to \$600. to go towards your energy evaluations.
